As part of our ASPIRE day on Tuesday 9 July, your child will be participating in a Virtual Reality Safe Cycling training programme. We are working with The Bikeability Trust who are coordinating this project in conjuction with Active Travel England. This immersive cycle training project aims to:

- Enthuse children about cycling
- Increase their 'Road Riding Readiness'
- Increase the use of cycling where possible.

As a tutor group, your child will have the opportunity to carry out the bikeability instructor-led session within a one hour slot. The use of an ipad per student will enable a 360 degree POV visual of scenarios and key information to develop every child's road safety.
